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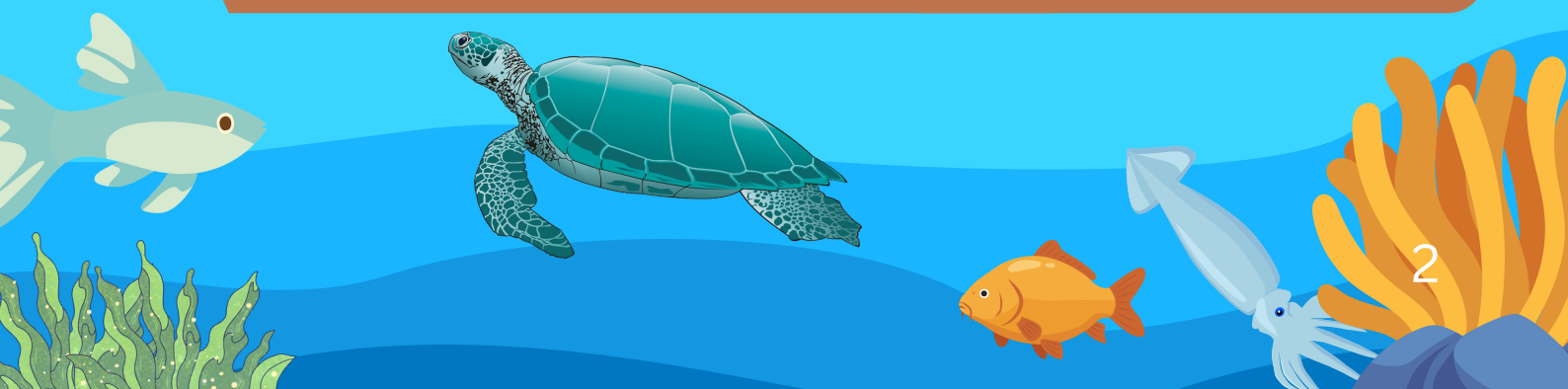

Egmore Museum or Madras Museum is India's second oldest museum and a premier cultural landmark established in 1851



The museum has a huge elephant skeleton and a giant Baleen whale skeleton. The whale skeleton is over 60 feet (18 meters) long and hangs from the ceiling. It came from a whale that was washed ashore in Mangalore in 1874, more than 150 years ago! Don't forget to check out these amazing giants!

★ *It has its own script with many letters.*

★ *The Malayalam script changed over time to make books easier.*

★ *The first printed Malayalam book, Sampkshepa Vedartham, was published in Rome in 1772.*

★ *In 2013, the Government of India recognized Malayalam as a Classical Language.*

★ *Malayalam being the language most spoken in Kerala, is an important part of Kerala's culture and heritage.*

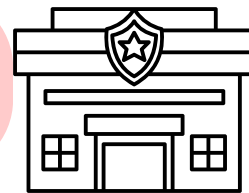

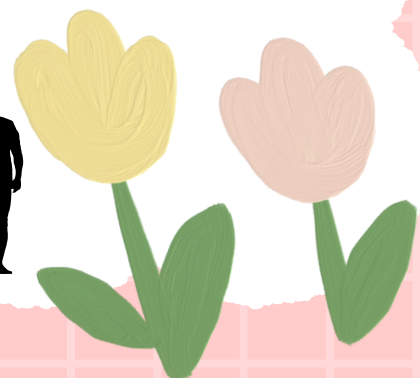
